(Backup: Fun, fun, fun, 'til her daddy takes the T-bird away)

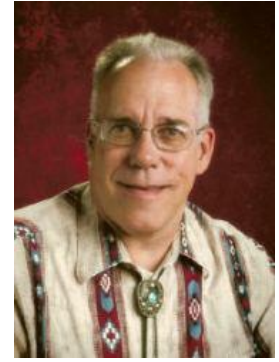
