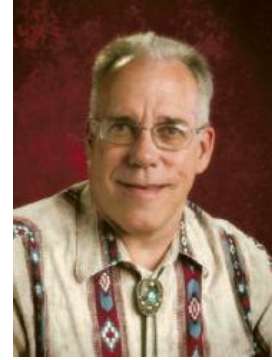

Opener/Break/Closer: (Sides Face Grand Square)

I'll go to my grave, Lovin' you, lovin' you
I'd give all I've saved, Lovin' you (Allemande Left and Weave)
And should I live again, You Swing and Promenade
For I'll go to my grave, Lovin' you, lovin' you

Figure:

Heads Square Thru, you count 'em four hands
With that corner, you Swing Thru
Now the Boys Run, Ferris Wheel
Centers Pass Thru, Slide Thru
Then Square Thru, count me three hands
Swing your corner, Promenade
For I'll go to my grave, Lovin' you, lovin' you

Break: (Sides Face Grand Square)

[Instrumental break] (Allemande Left and Weave)
And should I live again, You Swing and Promenade
For I'll go to my grave, Lovin' you, lovin' you

Closer: (Sides Face Grand Square)

I'll lay down my life, Lovin' you, lovin' you
I'd work day & night, Lovin' you (Allemande Left and Weave)
And when - life calls us both above, Honey you'll know - that you'd been loved
For I'll go to my grave, Lovin' you (Allemande Left and Swing)
