Break: (Sides Face Grand Square)

As she sewed, she told a story - from the bible, she had read,
'Bout a coat of many colors Joseph wore
(Allemande left & Weave) the ring
Oh I hope this coat will bring you good luck
Swing your girl and Promenade,
And I just couldn't wait to wear it, Momma blessed it with a kiss.

Closer: (Sides Face Grand Square)

That one is only poor only if they choose . (Allemande & Weave)
