It was from Aunt Dinah's quilting party
I was seeing Nelly Home

The Heads Square Thru count four
To the Corner you Dosado
You Swing Thru tonight let the Boys Run Right
Half Tag - Walk & Dodge and then (Partner Trade)
Pass the Ocean - Recycle 'round my friend
Swing your corner Promenade

I was seeing Nelly Home

Tag: (Allemande and Swing)
