Now the Heads Square Thru count 4, With the corner, you Dosado, Spin Chain Thru, Girls Circulate 2 times Box The Gnat, Pull her by Swing your corner, Promenade I'll even love you better than I did then

Break:

(16 Measures Steel Guitar Solo) (Allemande Left & Weave) (Swing and Promenade)

When you go for a walk, In the leaves when it's cold, Or lay when it's warm in the sun, With time on your hands, (And memories on your mind,) Or a long sleepless night has just begun.
