Opener: (Sides Face Grand Square)

Figure:

1 & 3 Square Thru get four hands, go,
You Dosado I say,
Swing Thru you go, Spin the Top
The Boy move up a Right & Left Thru you know,
You Touch a Quarter here and then the Girls Run Right,
Swing your corner 'round and Promenade tonight,
Next phase, new wave, dance craze, anyways
It's still rock and roll to me

Break:

Four Ladies Chain across the ring,
Rollaway you Circle a while,
Four Ladies Rollaway you Circle and then,
Left Allemande, Weave the Ring,
Where have you been hidin' out lately, Honey?
Swing with your girl and Promenade her honey,
So, everybody's talkin' 'bout the new sound, funny,
But it's still rock and roll to me.

Closer:

Four Boys Promenade a roll it inside,
You get back home and Swing your girl,
You join all your hands and now you Circle around,
Left Allemande, Weave the Ring,
Where have you been hidin' out lately, Honey?
You can't dress trashy till you spend a lot of money
Next phase, new wave, dance craze, anyways,
It's still rock and roll to me.

Tag: Give her a Swing,
Everybody's talkin' 'bout the new sound, funny,
But it's still rock and roll to me.
