**That's when I knew.

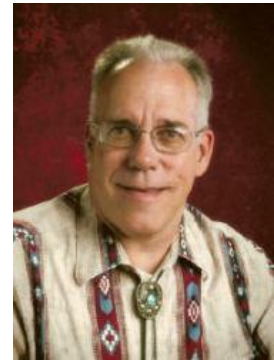
*But sitting here with you girl I just saw,
